**TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS:** Townships of Leroy, Locke, White Oak, Williamstown and City of Williamston, County of Ingham, and State of Michigan.

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that any qualified elector who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of their Township Clerk; City Clerk; the office of the County Clerk; a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agency. Registration forms can be obtained at [mi.gov/vote](http://mi.gov/vote) and mailed to their City or Township Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at [www.expressSOS.com](http://www.expressSOS.com).

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is **Monday, October 24, 2022**.

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at the elector's City or Township Clerk's office at the following times:

**STATE PROPOSALS:**

Proposal 22-1: "A proposal to amend the state constitution to require annual public financial disclosure reports by legislators and other state officers and change state legislator term limit to 12 total years in legislature".

Proposal 22-2: "A proposal to amend the state constitution to add provisions regarding elections".

Proposal 22-3: "A proposal to amend the state constitution to establish new individual right to reproductive freedom, including right to make all decisions about pregnancy and abortion; allow state to regulate abortion in some cases; and forbid prosecution of individuals exercising established right".
